INVITATION FOR BIDS

1. The Government of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, represented by the Government of Baluchistan, has received a credit (Cr: No: 5885-PAK) from the World Bank towards the cost of Baluchistan Integrated Water Resources Management and Development Project and intends to apply part of the funds to cover eligible payments under the contract for construction of Mushkaf Flood Irrigation Scheme. The project site is located at 23 km from Dhadhar Town and 21 km from Sibi on Quetta-Sibi highway.
2. The Government of Baluchistan, represented by the Project Director, Baluchistan Integrated Water Resources Management and Development Project, of the Department of Irrigation, invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the construction of Mushkaf Flood Irrigation Scheme. Bidding will be conducted through International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures as specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers (January 2011/Revised 2014) and will be opened to all bidders from eligible source countries as defined in the Guidelines. Registration with the Pakistan Engineering Council for the current year (i.e. 2018) in relevant category is a mandatory condition.
2. Bidding Documents (and additional copies) will be available by 12th November, 2018 and may be purchased from the Office of the Project Director, BIWRMD Project, 252-B, Jinnah Town, Samungli Road, Quetta, for a non refundable fee of Rs. 3,000.00 (Pak Rupees Three Thousand only) for each set. The Bidding Documents can also be dispatched through courier but charges will be borne by the recipient.
3. Bids will require to be valid for a period of one hundred twenty (120) days after bid opening and must be accompanied by prescribed bid security (ie. 2% of the Bid Amount) in shape of Bank Guarantee only. Sealed bids must be delivered to the above office on or before 12.00 noon, on **31st December, 2018**. Bids received will be opened immediately thereafter in the presence of the bidders who wish to attend. 4. Prospective bidders should note that Stamp Duty shall be payable on the Contract Price in accordance with the Baluchistan Finance Act, 1995 and that advance withholding tax will be deducted from payments due under the Contract in accordance with the Income Tax Ordinance, 1979; both act and ordinance as amended or modified or re-enacted from time to time in accordance with the latest legislation.
5. Bidders will be required to submit with their bids, qualification information specified in the bidding documents. These information will be used to determine whether the bidder is qualified to perform the works, against the qualification criteria provided in the bidding documents.

6. Bidders will be required to fill in rates and amounts (in Rupees) against each item of the Bill of Quantities. Rates quoted in form of a percentage above/below the Composite Schedule of Rates is unacceptable and may result in rejection of the bid.

7. Bidders are expected to give their best and final price as no negotiations are allowed.

8. In accordance with the provisions of the bidding documents, firms involved in corrupt or fraudulent practices (including pooling/collusion) will be declared ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, for award of a World Bank financed contract.
