



Report on Meeting with Ghazi Bugti and others

The social team had a meeting with the complainants (Ghazi Bugti and others) of Dahpal channel. The agenda of the meeting was to find a solution for the objection of Ghazi Bugti and other farmers of Dahpal channel. The meeting was held at the PIU Office, Sibi. Mr. Ghazi Bugti the complainant along with 10 farmers objected that the FO of Dahpal was formulated by selection rather than election. He said that they do not accept this FO and either reformulate this FO or formulate another FO for Dahpal.

The social team briefed Ghazi Bugti and the others about the overall project and shared the project design. Furthermore, the social team told the guests that this project is not any ordinary project and it is not for a specific number of people but it is for the whole community collectively. The team further told them that this project is not only working on the irrigation schemes but it is also working on Livestock, Public health, Environment, Matching grants, and Forest, where many plants and trees will be planted for the environment change and grazing purpose. This project will surely change the livelihood of Sibi.

Moreover, the social team explained the purpose and benefits of the FO. The team told them outright that the main purpose of the FO is to solve any problems that occurs during the project and that the whole community co-operates during the project. The team also told them that neither the members of the FO will be paid nor any farmer will be paid money in cash by this project. The members of the FO will only work with us voluntarily. In conclusion, the social team asked them for a solution but they rejected the current FO and insisted on reformation of the FO. Hence, the social team agreed on reformation



and told them to bring majority votes otherwise the current FO will be considered as the FO of Dahpal.
