- 1. The *Government of Pakistan* has received credit from the International Development Association towards the cost of Balochistan Integrated Water Resources Management and Development Project (BIWRMDP) and intends to apply part of the funds to cover eligible payments under the Contracts for Works of following schemes:
 - Nimmi Perennial Irrigation Scheme District Lasbella
 - Water Supply Scheme for Villages of Mushkaf Flood Irrigation Scheme, District Bolan.

Bidding is open to all bidders from eligible source countries as defined in the Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits and Grants by World Bank Borrowers" dated January 2011 revised July 2014 (Procurement Guidelines).

- 2. The *Project Director, BIWRMDP* invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the Works of Construction of above mentioned schemes.
- 3. Bidding documents (and additional copies) may be purchased at Office of the Project Director, Balochistan Integrated Water Resources Management and Development Project, 215-B, Jinnah Town, Quetta (Ph # +92-81-287070 and E-mail bssip@ yahoo.com) for a nonrefundable fee of Rs. 3000/= for each set of each scheme. Interested bidders may obtain further information at the same address. Additional Charges of Rs. 500 for each set will be payable if the documents are required through courier.

The completion period for Nimmi and Mushkaf WSS will 540 and 365 days respectively . The works for **Nimmi Perennial Irrigation Scheme** comprise of construction of intake structures, super passages, aqueducts and outlets across various channels. The works of **Water Supply Scheme for villages of Mushkaf Flood Irrigation** Scheme comprise of providing and laying of pipeline, construction of surface and overhead water tanks, drilling and development of solar powered tube wells and pump houses.

- 4. Bids shall be valid for a period of 91 days after Bid opening, must be accompanied by security of 2% of the Bid Price and delivered to Project Director, Balochistan Integrated Water Resources Management and Development Project, 215-B, Jinnah Town, Quetta on or before 12:00 hours PST of 15thApril, 2019 at which time they will be opened in the presence of bidders who choose to attend.
- 5. The Procurement process will be conducted in accordance with the *National Competitive Bidding (NCB) method* in accordance with paragraph 3.3 of "Guidelines Procurement of Goods, Works, And Non-Consulting Services Under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers (January 2011 revised 2014)".

- 6. A pre-bid conference will be held at 11:00 hrs on 1st April 2019 at the Office of the Project Director, Balochistan Integrated Water Resources Management and Development Project, 215-B, Jinnah Town, Quetta. The purpose of the meeting will be to clarify site and various other issues and to answer questions on any matter that may be raised at that stage. All potential Bidders that have obtained the Bidding Documents are invited to attend.
- 7. All bidders shall be required to submit along with their bids, qualification information specified in the bidding documents. This information shall be used to establish through post-qualification whether the bidder is qualified to perform the work.
- 8. Bids are required to be submitted on item rate basis (not on the basis of Composite Schedule of Rates with percentage premium) and the rates and amounts (in Rupees) must be filled by the bidder for each item in the Bill of Quantities and provide a total price. Non-compliance may result in rejection of bid.
- 9. Bidders should give their best and final price in their bids as no negotiations are permissible.
- 10. As provided in the bidding documents, bidders engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices (including collusion/pooling) will be declared ineligible, either in indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to be awarded a contract financed by the World Bank.
